Currently Eligible Categories and Shot Clinic Schedule

WHO: Phase 1a ER, Urgent Care Workers, First Responders

In and Outpatient Health Care Support

Non-clinical staff authorized to receive vaccine from DoD. National Guard, Reserve, Active Duty supporting COVID-19 response.

Phase 1b & c Commissary; Navy Exchange; Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR); Child Youth Programs; Child Development Center; W.T. Sampson School (DODEA); Office of Military Commissions; Marine Security Forces; Intelligence personnel; Food Services Department; Post Office staff; and Vectrus shuttle and bus drivers. Personnel, including Civilians and Dependents, departing NSGB on OCONUS PCS orders within 90 days and anyone 65 years or older. The COVID-19 vaccine is also being offered on a prescription basis to at-risk or high-risk individuals.

WHEN: February 3, 4 and 5. Vaccine service hours will be 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Wednesdays and Thursdays, and 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Fridays.

If you are not in the current phase of personnel receiving the vaccine, you will have an opportunity to receive your shot during the next phase. Dates and other details will be announced when available.
