- This policy is effective immediately and **applies to ALL passengers.**

OUTBOUND PASSENGERS

As of Jan. 27, 2021

- Effective Jan. 27, "<u>Space-Available</u>" and "<u>Non-funded EML</u>" passengers (age 2 yrs +) DEPARTING NSGB for CONUS, MUST provide Air Terminal personnel 'Proof of Negative COVID-19 Test Results <u>dated within 72 hours of flight</u> (as per <u>Federal Regulation</u>).
- Personnel Departing NSGB on Government-Funded Orders <u>are</u> <u>currently exempt</u> from this requirement.
- Passengers unable to provide proof of negative COVID-19 test results will be <u>DENIED</u> travel.
- Naval Hospital Guantanamo Bay <u>will provide COVID-19 Testing</u> for outbound passengers. (See next slide for testing details)





Additional Considerations

- Prescription medications and glasses
- Infant formula and diapers
- Pet food and extra water for your pet
- Cash or traveler's checks and change
- Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a waterproof, portable container.
- Household chlorine bleach (Can be used to disinfect and purify water)
- Fire extinguisher
- Matches in a waterproof container
- Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates, paper towels and plastic utensils
- Paper and pencil
- Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

Basic Emergency Supplies Kit

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation
- Food, at least a three-day supply of nonperishable food
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio tuned to Radio GTMO (FM 102.1 and 103.1 AM 1340)
- Flashlight and extra batteries (one per two people)
- First aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Manual can opener for food
- Local maps
- Command Muster information
