

COVID-19 Vaccine by Appointment

To make an appointment at the Primary Care Clinic (PCC) follow this link to use the [DHA Appointing Portal \(DAP, Guantanamo Bay\)](#).

- 1) Read the instruction on the landing page
- 2) Click 'NEXT' at the bottom of the page
- 3) Choose Appropriate DOSE
- 4) Click on the date that coincides with the type of vaccine you want (This information is on the landing page. If it is NOT on the landing page, select the corresponding date provided on the Appointment Vaccine Schedule posted on the hospital FB page and on the Immunizations.
- 5) On the right hand side a window with time slots will open. Click on the time slot you prefer.
- 6) Complete the information* (see Additional Tips below)
- 7) Click 'Next' at bottom of page

On your appointment day report 5-10 minutes early to the PCC on first floor (from Quarterdeck, proceed straight down main hall, make left at double elevators.) Plan to spend about one hour for your appointment for vaccination and 15 minute observation following vaccination.

***Additional Tips for making a COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment at USNH Guantanamo Bay**

Here are a few tips that may help when using the [DAP tool \(Guantanamo Bay\)](#) to make an appointment for either Moderna or Janssen Vaccines, Pfizer or Pediatric Pfizer.

- 1) Look for the day that coincides with the vaccine you prefer and make your appointment for that day. (If this information is not on the landing page, select the date that coincides with dates provided on the website under COVID-19 Vaccine Appointments).
- 2) You may use your PHONE NUMBER INSTEAD of a DOD Identification Number.
- 3) In the portion that asks for your phone number, be sure to use hyphens as shown, or the tool will not let you proceed.
- 4) If you are unable to book an appointment with the DAP or if you are having problems, you may call the PCC at 7-2944 or 7-2945 for assistance.
- 5) Use links on this page for easy access to [Guantanamo Bay DAP](#).
- 6) If there are no open appointments (blue calendar days), you may call the PCC to ask when the next slots will open. Appointment windows are open in increments of 10, the number of doses in a vial. If you are unable to make an appointment or have question call 7-2944 or 7-2945.
