Face Mask Requirement until Nov. 22, 2021

ALL personnel on NSGB, REGARDLESS of Vaccination Status, are required to wear protective face masks covering their nose and mouth inside all buildings and facilities on the installation.

- Required to maintain social distancing
- Applies to Fully Vaccinated AND Unvaccinated Individuals
- Excludes children below the age of 2
- Excludes when in individual housing/quarters, when exercising and when eating/drinking

Effective November 22, 2021, vaccinated personnel will not be required to wear masks.

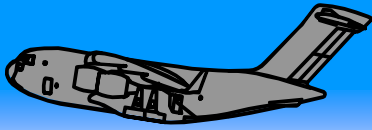

Inbound Passengers Require COVID-19 Test

As of Jan. 15, 2021

- Per USTRANSCOM, **ALL Passengers** from CONUS to Naval Station Guantanamo Bay, Cuba **MUST** provide Air Terminal personnel **'Proof of Negative COVID-19 Test Results'** *dated within three days of flight.*
- This policy is effective immediately and **applies to ALL passengers.**
- Policy Updates will be announced when available.

OUTBOUND PASSENGERS

As of Jan. 27, 2021

- **Effective Jan. 27, “Space-Available” and “Non-funded EML” passengers (age 2 yrs +) **DEPARTING NSGB for CONUS, MUST** provide Air Terminal personnel ‘**Proof of Negative COVID-19 Test Results** *dated within 72 hours of flight* (as per Federal Regulation).**
- **Personnel Departing NSGB on Government-Funded Orders are currently exempt** from this requirement.
- **Passengers unable** to provide proof of negative COVID-19 test results **will be DENIED travel.**
- Naval Hospital Guantanamo Bay will provide COVID-19 Testing for outbound passengers. **(See next slide for testing details)**
