Travelers to Naval Station Guantanamo Bay may use home tests for pre-flight COVID testing within 72 hours of flight. The home test must meet these specifications from <u>Air Mobility Command (AMC)</u> and <u>Centers for Disease Control CDC</u>:

"You can use a self-test (sometimes referred to as home test) that meets the following criteria:

- The test must be a SARS-CoV-2 viral test (Nucleic Acid Amplification Test or an Antigen Test) with Emergency Use Authorization from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration OR the relevant national authority where the test is administered.
- The testing procedure must include a telehealth service affiliated with the manufacturer of the test that provides real-time supervision remotely through an audio and video connection.

  Some FDA-authorized self-tests that include a telehealth service may require a prescription.
- The telehealth provider must confirm your identity, observe the sample collection and testing procedures, confirm the test result, and issue a report that meets the requirements of CDC's Order (see: "What information must be included in the test result?" below).
- Airlines and other aircraft operators must be able to review and confirm your identity and the
  test result details. You must also be able to present the documentation of test results to U.S.
  officials at the port of entry and local/state health departments, if requested.

Some countries may restrict importation of tests that are not authorized or registered there. If you are considering bringing a U.S.-authorized test with you for use outside of the United States, contact authorities at your destination for information before you travel.

A test result must be in the form of written documentation (paper or digital copy). The documentation must include:

- 1. Type of test (indicating it is a NAAT or antigen test)
- 2. Entity issuing the result (e.g., laboratory, healthcare entity, or telehealth service)
- 3. Sample collection date
  - a. A negative test result must show the sample was taken no more than 1 day before the flight.
  - b. A positive test result for documentation of recovery from COVID-19 must show the sample was taken within the 90 days before the flight.
  - 4. Information that identifies the person (full name plus at least one other identifier such as date of birth or passport number)
  - 5. Test result"
